

English as Second Language (ESL)

Kingston University facilitates non-English speaking students attaining their goals of admission to degree programs or pursuit of other educational trainings. There are altogether six levels of classes, with the highest level being Pre-College level which is designed to help students preparing for college course works including academic lectures and study techniques for research. All ESL students are required to take an English Placement Test to determine English skill level at the beginning of each term in order to be placed into an appropriate level for developing their English abilities.

Upon completion of the program, students should be prepared to take a TOEFL exam for admission to their appropriate school for further education. The program will prepare the student to do research, communicate concepts, to participate in discussion groups and to achieve a level of English communication skills appropriate to their selected study level.

Program Objectives



Upon completion students should be able to:

1. Demonstrate an ability to do complex research projects using English as their secondary language
2. Demonstrate an ability to use verbal and auditory skills within an American college setting
3. Function within American culture using English as a supportive language to pursue further college or graduate training.
4. Understand areas for further developing and refinement of English communication skills.
5. Take and pass a TOEFL test for admission to their selected college or university.

American Cultural, Science and Art Camp

Kingston University also offers English language training programs with curriculum designs tailored to the background, level of English proficiency and special interests of a student group. The curriculum will enable participants experience American culture, custom, art and science in a limited time frame while learning English skill.
